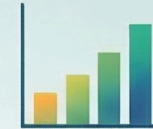

Proactive Disclosure & Literacy

Move beyond fine print to active AI literacy programs explaining system logic & human impact.



Participatory Governance

Establish employee-led AI Ethics Boards or "AI Champions" to review systems before deployment.
